Dear Professor Della Posta:

I am pleased to inform you that on the basis of the referees' reports and the advice by a member of the Editorial Board of *Metroeconomica* I have decided to accept your submission, MS 1657, entitled

"A Market-Financed and Growth-Enhancing Investment Plan for the Euro Area".

for publication in *Metroeconomica*.

The next steps in the process that will lead to the publication of your paper are the following.

(1) Send the accepted version of your paper in Word or LaTeX format to Aurora Maltinti <aurora.maltinti@unipi.it> (if you want to send a LaTeX format, please put all relevant documents within a single folder, zip it, and send the zip document). Please make sure that in the paper you express your gratitude to the anonymous referees.

(2) Your article cannot be published until the publisher has received the appropriate signed license agreement. Within few days after receipt of the documents mentioned in (1) the corresponding author will receive an email from Wiley's Author Services system which will ask you to log in and will present you with the appropriate license for completion.

(3) Typically no later than 40 days after you will be sent electronically galley proofs and the copy-editor's queries. Make sure that you return the corrected galley proofs as soon as possible.

(4) Shortly after you have returned the proofs you will be requested to approve of the publication of your paper in *Metroeconomica* Online Early articles. Make sure that you send the approval as soon as possible.

(5) Once your paper has been published in *Metroeconomica* Online Early articles, the Managing Editors will decide in which issue the paper will come out. Any delay in returning the galley proofs or in sending the approval may cause a considerable delay in the publication of your piece. It is in your very best interest to help us in speeding up the process.

Finally, in the interest of increasing the visibility of your work and the outlet in which it will be published, in case an earlier version of the paper has been made available to the scientific community as a working or discussion paper, we ask you to trace the readers of the paper and inform them about the imminent publication of your paper. You may then ask them to kindly refer to the published version in any of their works in which they cite your piece.
